MAY 15, 1948 - THE DAY THE ILLEGAL STATE OF ISRAEL WAS CREATED - and it is the day Palestinians and the world alike, remember as **AL-NAKBA** ("The Catastrophe").

By the end of 1948, terrorist (Zionist) militias had driven out 750,000 Palestinians and there are 5 million Palestinian refugees waiting to return to their homeland today.

This marks the beginning of Palestinian exile and ethnic cleansing from Palestine - cleansing that continues today.

FERNANDO GONZÁLEZ one of the Cuban Five heroes, and now, Vice-President of "Instituto Cubano de Amistad con Los Pueblos" (ICAP – English translation: "Cuban Institute of Friendship with the Peoples"). Fernando was released and returned to Cuba after 15 years in a U.S. prison for fighting terrorism against Cuba. He will speak about US Aggression in Relation to Cuba
